



Lighting

Natural Light

- ◆ First light source to consider.
- ◆ Sunlight that enters the house through windows, doors, skylights, etc.
- ◆ North or East—Cool, bluish cast
- ◆ South or West—Warm, orange tones



Incandescent Light

- ◆ Light bulb most people use.
- ◆ Burns about 700-1000 hours.



Fluorescent Lighting

- ◆ Lasts up to ten times longer than an incandescent bulb.
- ◆ Use less electricity and produce no damaging heat.
- ◆ Not as homey and comfortable.



Halogen Lighting

- ◆ Lamp is kept brighter than incandescent bulbs.
- ◆ Light is more similar to that of sunlight.
- ◆ Bulbs burn whiter than incandescent bulbs.



Types of Lighting

- ◆ General
 - Overall lighting.



- ◆ Task
 - Lighting a small space to perform a specific task; reading, cooking, eating.



- ◆ Accent/Decorative
 - Used to draw attention to specific areas or objects.



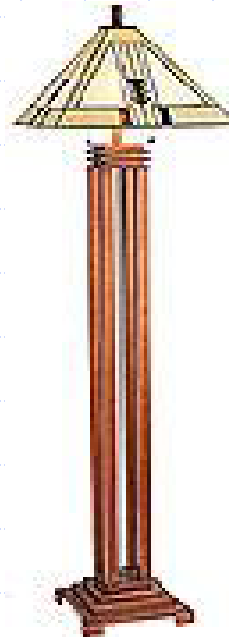

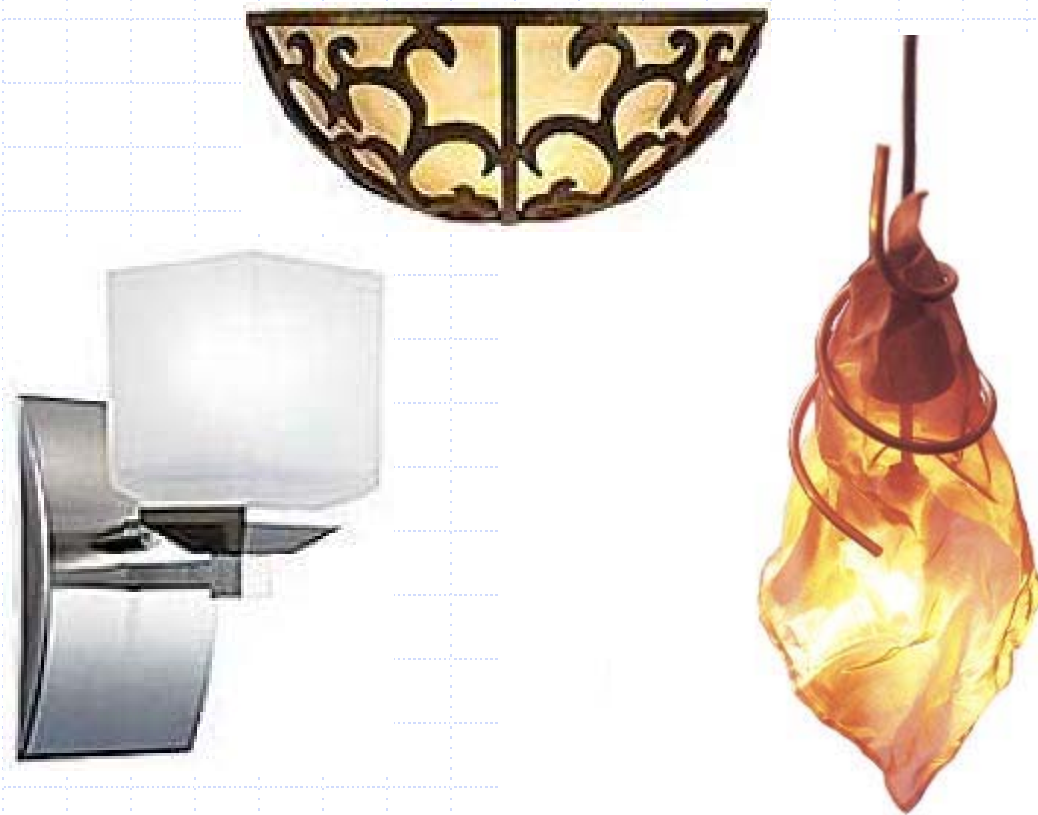
