Lighting

Natural Light

- First light source to consider.
- Sunlight that enters the house through windows, doors, skylights, etc.
- North or East—Cool, bluish cast
- South or West—Warm, orange tones



Incandescent Light

- Light bulb most people use.
- Burns about 700-1000 hours.



Fluorescent Lighting

- Lasts up to ten times longer than an incandescent bulb.
- Use less electricity and produce no damaging heat.
- Not as homey and comfortable.



Halogen Lighting

- Lamp is kept brighter than incandescent bulbs.
- Light is more similar to that of sunlight.
- Bulbs burn whiter than incandescent bulbs.



Types of Lighting

- General
 - Overall lighting.



- Task
 - Lighting a small space to perform a specific task; reading, cooking, eating.

- Accent/Decorative
 - Used to draw attention to specifi areas or objects.


