Teaching Tolerance for Diversity

Background for Teachers

Teachers need to be familiar with the civil rights time period and people associated with it.

Student Prior Knowledge

Students need to be aware of the diversity in people around them.

Intended Learning Outcomes

Students will be able to recognize and appreciate the uniqueness of people by participating in interdisciplinary activities.

Instructional Procedures

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Exploration I, creativity: Students will read the biographies listed in the Hotlist. Chose one person to write an acrostic poem on.

Exploration II , game: Students will review the biographies from the Hotlist. Next they will play the matching game that matches the person's name to the description of their contribution.

Text Station: Students will choose one or more of the poems to read. As they read, they make a

list of descriptive words. When finished, they choose five words and write a written summary of the poem.

Technology Station: Using the CultureGrams on the UEN site, students will choose a country and create a three meal menu using foods from the country.

Gifted Strategies: Students do their own research and add to the list of people who influenced civil rights.
