Intended Learning Outcomes

Understand the purpose of using online databases. Know how to navigate the Gale Reference Collection 9-12.

Instructional Procedures

Library teacher explains the rationale for using online databases (Whole Group). Students explore the Gale Reference Collection 9-12 and complete the handout. Teachers circulate to answer questions (Individual Work).

Debriefing -- What did you like/dislike? How can this database help you? What was interesting? (Whole Group.)
