AI Activities Update – Jim Stewart and Committee Members

REN Community AI Working Group:

- Principles:
 - Gain experience with industrial AI, including GPU farms, compute power, large language models, and machine learning.
 - Collaborate as a community
- Goals:
 - Explore how UETN can facilitate secure areas for testing and developing AI tools.

UETN Security Update – Troy Jessup

- Statewide Cybersecurity Assessment:

UETN is completing an assessment conducted by CompuNet, revealing deficiencies in K-12 cybersecurity recourses and vulnerability scanning practices.

- Managed Detection and Response Solution (MDR):
 - UETN has secured funding from the ARPA project to purchase a MDR solution for all LEAs in the state.
 - The solution is provided by Adlumin, will be deployed on April 1, 2025, with the goal of full implementation within 90 days.
 - Currently, 93% of school districts have signed up.
 - Committee members are interested in participating in consortium-based EDR services and vulnerability scanning services.
 - Consortium-based pricing will benefit the LEAs, who often lack sufficient funds for cybersecurity tools
