







WI-FI COVERAGE REPORTED BY SCHOOLS (%)




SCHOOLS EXPERIENCING DECLINES IN WI-FI SERVICE SPEEDS DURING SCHOOLTIME (%)

- Other, or no Wi-Fi


HOW SCHOOL WI-FI NETWORKS WERE DESIGNED




- Outside contractor conducted a professional Wi-Fi design


