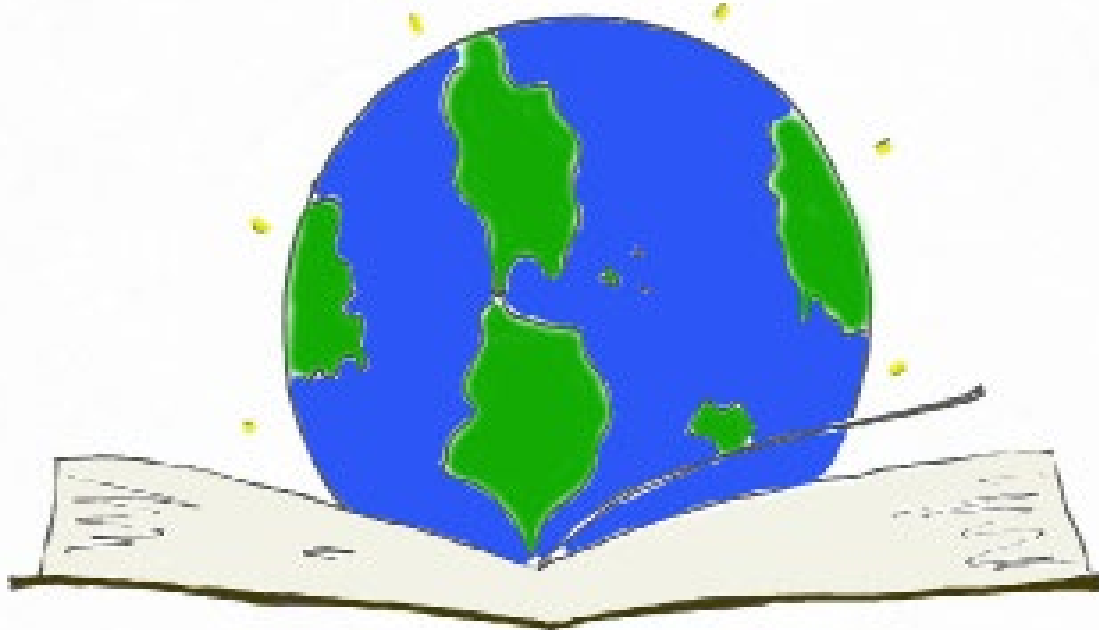
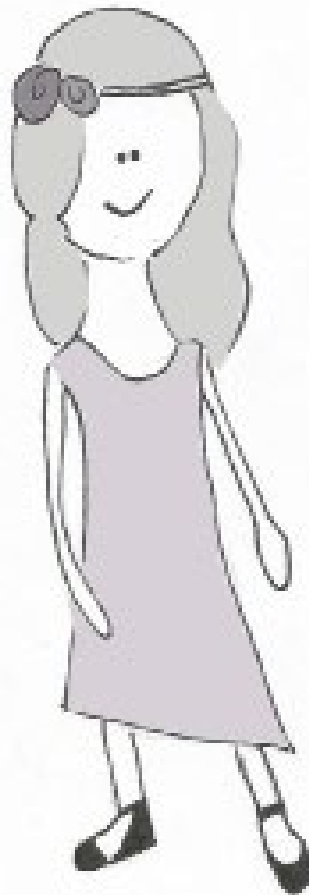


Pearl's

One day Pearl decided to do something other than play on her tablet, like her friends would. She grabbed a book and went outside.

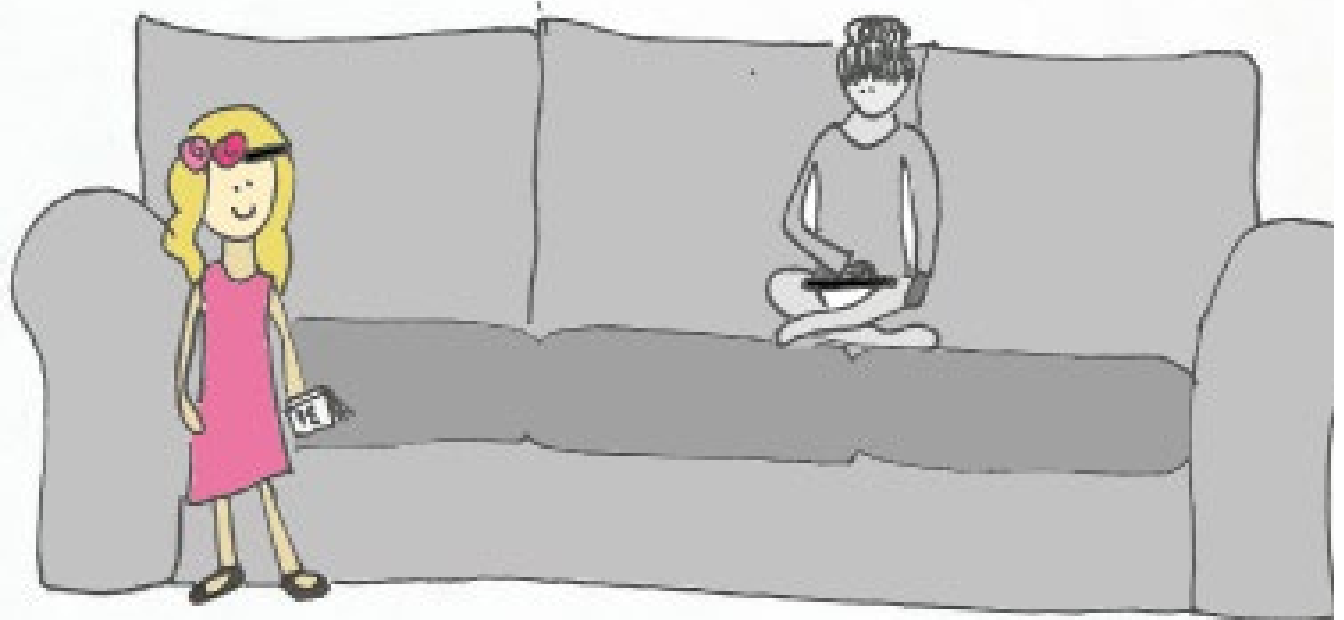




While reading, she fought dragons and went on adventures that she could not have done on her tablet. When she read the book, her eyes lit up and her life was full of color.

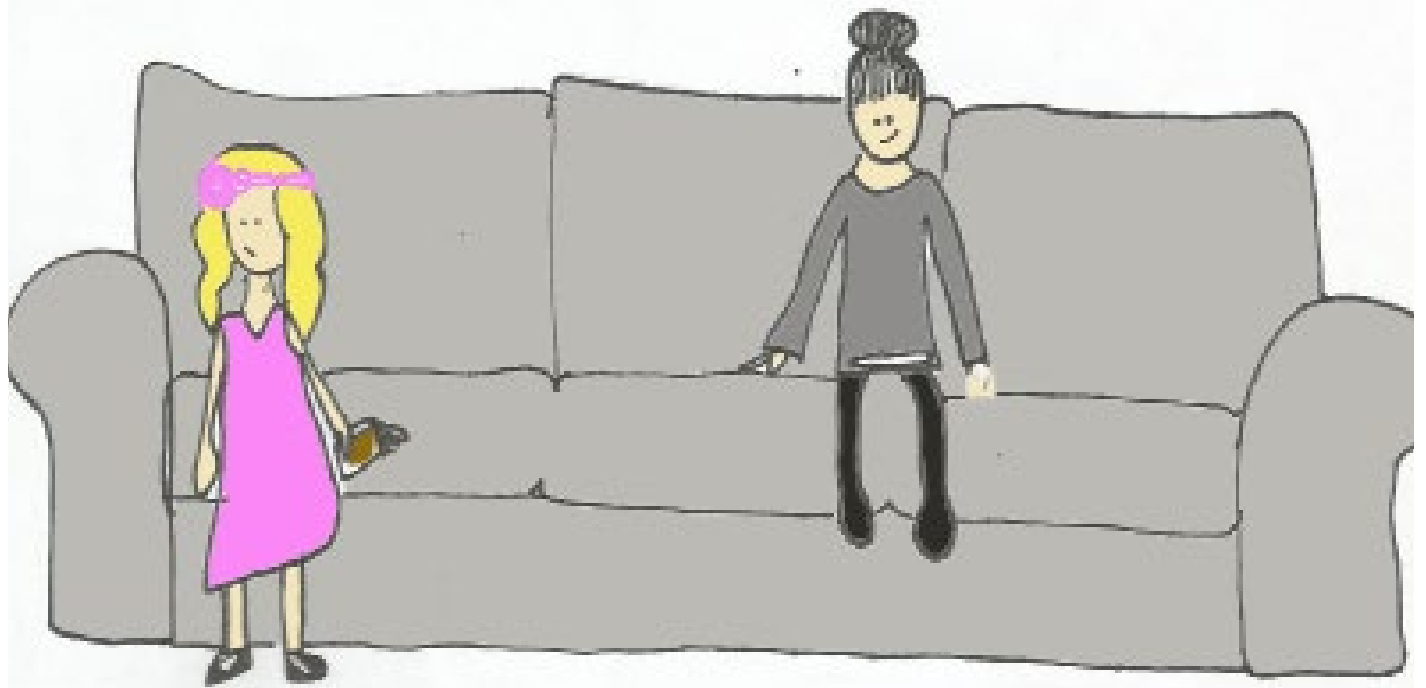


Pearl wanted to share her experience with Rose, her best friend. When she found Rose, she was sitting on the couch watching her favorite show.

Rose replied, "Watching my show can take you on adventures as well, and reading is so boring. Come sit down with me." Pearl refused and went on her way.

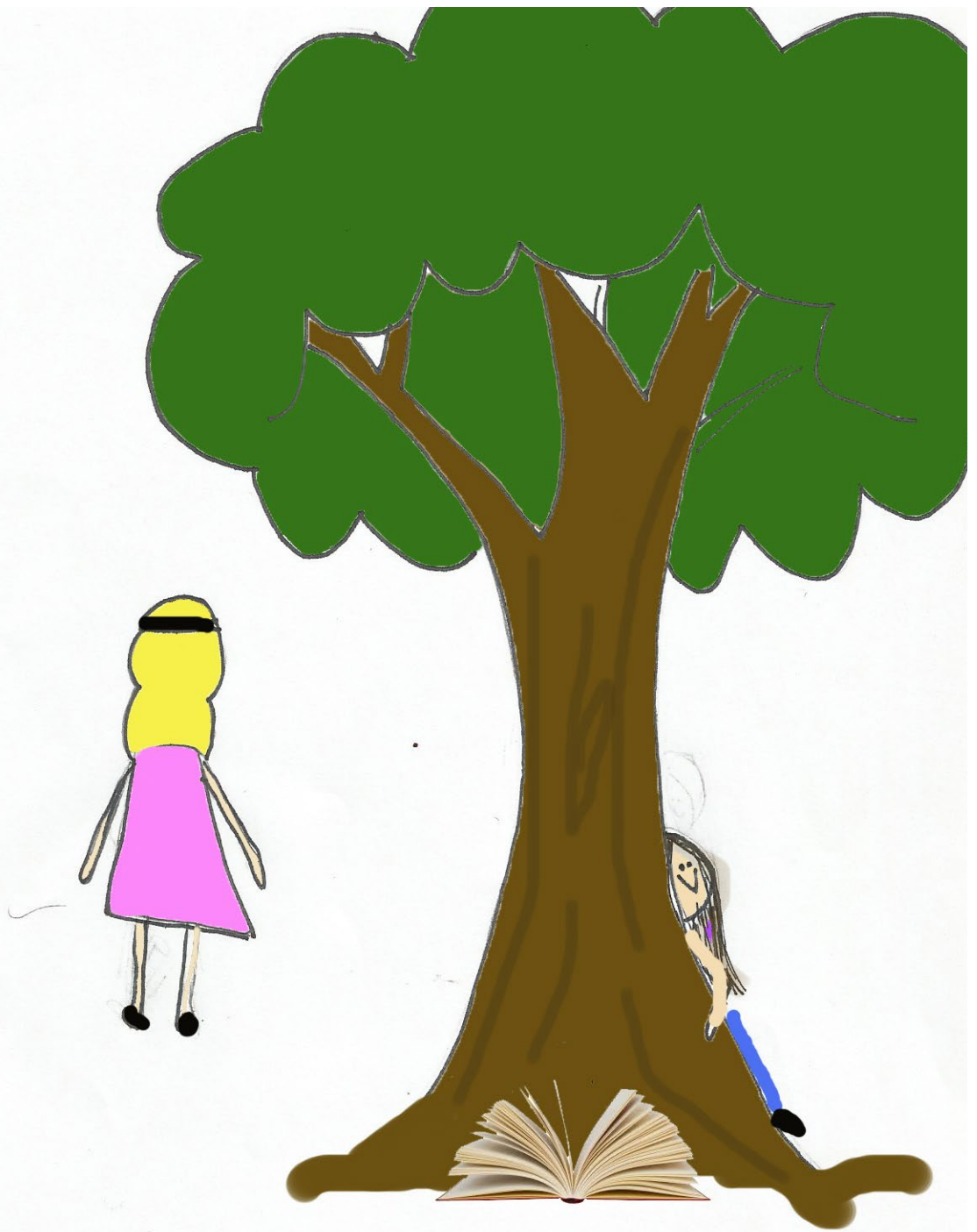




Pearl spent the rest of the day looking for people who would read the book with her. Henry, Sarah, and Charlie all said they would rather stay on their devices.

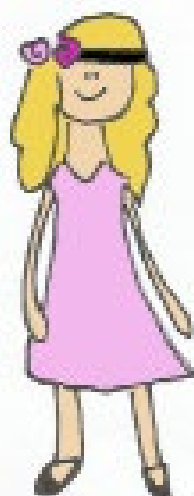


Pearl was sad that none of her friends wanted to read with her. She sat in the shade of a tree and continued to enjoy her book alone.
